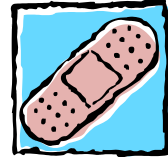

May 20 **Soil Studies** — Soil has a major role in the life of plants and animals. Come explore the many interesting facets of this life-giving combination.



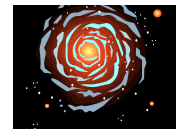
June 17 **Honeybee Farms** — Bees are amazing little workers. Join us as we learn about these bees, the apiarists, and their farms.
