- Each *Simply Science and Studies* class includes hands-on learning and take home assignments. Homework is required for greater retention.
- Testing is done to encourage mastery.
- A report card will be given at the end of each session to showcase the child's learning achievements in a continually positive manner.

- Each class has a minimum registration of 10 students. If this minimum is not met, the class may be cancelled at the discretion of the instructor.

Other things to do...

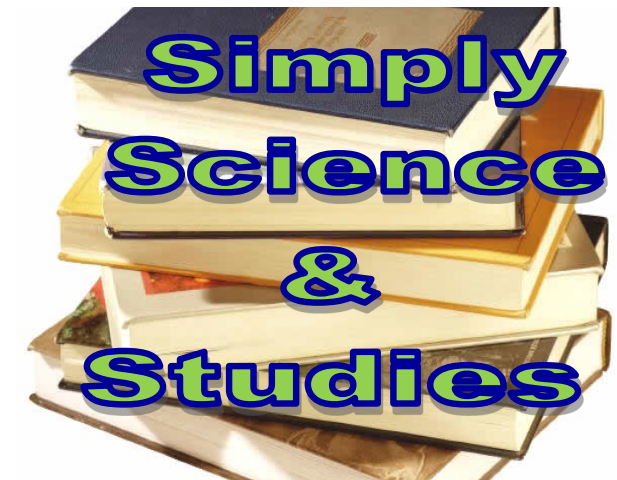

- **Who:** Home-Educated Students in the 7-12th Grades
